Agreement on Scientific Cooperation between the National Research Council of Italy (CNR) and the Romanian Academy (RA)

The National Research Council of Italy (CNR) and the Romanian Academy (RA) (hereinafter referred to as the Parties), have agreed upon the following provisions:

Article I – Purpose

The purpose of this Agreement is to further strengthen cooperation in scientific research between Italy and Romania. The Parties will, on a basis of equality and mutual benefit, promote and support cooperation between qualified scientists of both institutions in those research areas of most interest to both Parties.

Article II - Forms of cooperation and Implementation

This Agreement on scientific cooperation may include the following activities:

a) Joint research projects

Article III - Practice

The details and the Cooperative Programme for each form of cooperation shall be decided by the Parties. Each Party will cover the costs of the participants from its own country. The number of projects will be contingent upon funding availability in each Party's budget, which will be established on the renewed Cooperative Programme.

Article IV - Observance of Regulations

Participating scientists abide by the laws of the receiving country and regulations of the host institutions.

Article V - Intellectual Properties

Intellectual property rights shall belong to the researcher(s) and/or the researcher's employing institution. Due acknowledgement of support received from the parties should be made in any publication resulting from the research.

Article VI - Other Matters

Administrative procedures and implementation details not stipulated in this Agreement will be provided separately in the Cooperative Programme or agreed upon via correspondence.

Article VII - Validity, Amendment, Termination

This Agreement will come into force on the date of its signing.

This Agreement may be suspended by the Parties with notification in advance of the launch of call for proposals.

This Agreement is made and signed in two originals in English language.
