

Bilateral Agreement CNR / MOST**Joint Research Projects 2021-2022****Final Report**

Considering the Joint Bilateral Agreement signed on October 1, 2019, the joint call for the bilateral project program launched on April 20, 2020, both Parties have jointly decided to fund, within the framework of the future joint program, 4 projects granting 25.000 Euros/200.000 RMB per project every year, for a total of 2 years.

After the evaluation procedures performed independently by both Parties, the assessed projects obtaining the highest scores have been taken into account.

The Parties agreed to finance the following proposals included in a final ranking list:


