



Final Report of the Joint Bilateral Agreement CNR/SAS (Slovak Academy of Sciences)

Biennial Program 2023-2024

Considering the General Agreement signed on April 2019 and the joint call for the bilateral project program launched on April 2022 Following on to our agreements, both Parties agreed on funding up to 4 joint research projects (CNR will provide up 3.000,00 euros per year for 2 years to the Italian team, and SAS will provide up 3.000,00 euros per year for 2 years to the Slovak team).

At the deadline foreseen by the call, 8 proposals have been submitted to both parties.

After the evaluation step performed independently by both Parties, CNR and SAS decided to fund 4 projects.

After comparing both evaluations, the Parties agreed to fund the 4 projects with the total highest score.

Despite the large number of good proposals received, the Parties agreed on the following final ranking list of the financed proposals:
