Considering the Joint Bilateral Agreement signed on September 24, 2012, the joint call for the bilateral project program launched on April 10, 2019, both Parties have jointly decided to fund, within the framework of the future joint program, 3 projects granting 10.000 Euros per project for 2 years.

After the evaluation procedures performed independently by both Parties, the assessed projects obtaining the highest scores have been taken into account.
