TECO boosted research and innovation collaboration between EU and India in the field of environment, specifically on the innovations for the decontamination of polluted waters and soils.


TECO stimulated new opportunities for the private sector to deliver appropriate innovations even through a reinforced link among research, public institutions and private companies.




