Abstracts submitted by fax or e-mail will not be accepted. Presenters can submit a maximum of **three abstracts**.

All abstracts must be submitted in English. Please do not submit multiple copies of the same abstract.

All abstracts will be forwarded to the Scientific and Program Committee for review.

Once submitted, your abstract can be amended within the deadline: **January 31st, 2019**.

After the review by the Scientific and Program Committee, authors will be notified about results by **April 15th, 2019**. If an abstract is accepted, the **presenting author must register and pay the registration fee before May 31st, 2019**, in order to be included in the program and in the proceedings.

Authors with accepted abstracts will be invited to submit an extended version of their paper to be included the conference proceedings.
