## Civic Computing for Youth Participation in Colombia: Leveraging Data Literacy in Colombia

The seminar will offer an opportunity to explore a project developed by Prof. Camilo Vieira, which examines how young people aged 15 to 24 in Barranquilla (Colombia) engage with data literacy as a means of civic participation.

Using a design-based research approach, the project supports the co-design of participatory learning environments that aim to strengthen technical skills-such as data visualization and storytelling-while fostering critical reflection on local civic issues.

During the seminar, early research findings will be presented, highlighting the potential of civic computing to support more inclusive, informed, and change-oriented youth engagement.
