Professor Paradiso participated in IGU Istanbul Congress by organizing sessions and interacting in the General Assembly.

IGU proposed Professor Maria Paradiso for nomination in ISC International Science Council in recognition of her commitment and achievements in IGU as well in recognition of her scientific experience internationally. She has successfully nominated in Fall 2021 with a large number of votes.

In 2022, Professor Paradiso proposed to the Italian community to submit again an Italian candidacy for IGU ballot for Vice President, in continuation of a 20 years tradition, which started with Professor Adalberto Vallega. In the past she has sustained the election of Professors Bellezza University of Sapienza first and then Dell'Agnese University Bicocca. Italian Geographers proposed Maria Paradiso for election.

Maria Paradiso has been sustained very well by IGU and y very successfully elected as IGU VP for the term 2022-2026. 51 National Committees cast their vote, which represents an 85% turnout of eligible countries. https://igu-online.org/igu-ec-election-result-2022/
