







stories and a living lab in Naples

Naples Meetings is the second event of the COST Action CA18110 Underground Built Heritage as catalyser for Community Valorisation. The Action establishes and implements an expert network, aiming at promoting balanced and sustainable approaches for the conservation of the underground heritage and, at the same time, realising the potential of underground space in urban and rural areas for regeneration policies. Experts are organised in five working groups: WG1 Underground Built Heritage (UBH) Knowledge Base Development; WG2 Underground Built Heritage conservation and monitoring; WG3 Underground Built Heritage reuse and valorisation strategies; WG4. Underground Built Heritage planning approaches; WG5 Dissemination and exploitation strategies. Each year, it investigates four case studies, reporting on governance mechanisms, planning framework, stakeholders' involvement management, financing mechanisms, technical needs, and their direct impacts on the underground built environment preservation, as well as potential negative externalities. By establishing living labs in the case studies, it stimulates interaction with local communities, dissemination of innovative thinking and support them to explore alternative social trajectories. Collected information provides knowledge on main barriers to the underground regeneration and correlated solutions.
