Overview

The Regional Training Centre (RTC) Italy of the World Meteorological Organization (WMO), established in Italy in 1987, is operated by the Institute of Bioeconomy of the National Research Council (CNR-IBE). The uniqueness of the RTC in Italy, within the network of 28 WMO RTCs, is that it serves both Region VI (Europe) and Region I (Africa) in collaboration with other local RTC. The RTC in Italy is a center of excellence in providing training in agrometeorology and innovative climate services for agriculture, water, and food security.

We believe training transforms into a two-way knowledge exchange, involving both trainees and trainers, cultivating institutional, professional, and personal relationships. 
Climate Change and Climate Variability and their effects or natural resources, water and agriculture.

Distance Learning

Even before the COVID-19 pandemic, the RTC had already developed and successfully implemented distance learning tools, resulting in high levels of student satisfaction.

These tools have been continuously enhanced and expanded, providing a wide array of integrated solutions that can seamlessly interface with external platforms. RTC Italy online training is integrated with Open Badges displaying WMO competencies acquired through the online training.

Our Network

Another distinctive aspect of the RTC in Italy is its capacity to conduct training activities directly in the beneficiary countries on the specific topics of their interest. Since the 1980s, the RTC has been engaged in training and development projects in Africa, often in close collaboration with the Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation (MAECI). Notably, the RTC and WMO are presently collaborating with MAECI on a significant capacity-building initiative centred on climate services for water and agriculture, encompassing the entire African continent.
