I'm an Italian Exploration Geologist with more than 10 years' experience in the Oil & Gas Industry, dealing with seismic and geological interpretation, cartographic database, seismic survey plan and supervision during the acquisition (offshore and onshore), structural modeling, volume calculations and New Ventures evaluation. Employed at small and mid-size O&G Companies, I mainly dealt with exploration and evaluation of geological oil&gas reservoirs starting by seismic interpretation.

At the moment I'm a Research Fellow at "Politecnico di Torino", working together with the Italian "Ministero dello Sviluppo Economico" in Rome, in several projects.

From 2016 to 2017 I worked in Irminio S.r.L., where I managed all the geological and geophysical data of fields and projects for the Company, mainly Sicilia onshore.

From 2012 to 2016 I did work for Medoilgas Italia, involved in seismic and geological interpretation and 3D modeling for Reservoir studies, both for Company's project and for new business opportunity, with a focus on Italy, Montenegro, Tunisia, Egypt, Malta, Croatia. I was the Company's Representative on board of seismic survey vessel during Well Site Survey and bed sampling operations in the Mediterranean Sea, South of Malta in 2013.

Previously, from 2006 to 2012, I worked in Independent Resources plc, where I dealt with exploration of geological oil and gas reservoir and reservoir for CO2 storage and Coal Bed Methane (CBM). I planned, managed and successfully executed 2D seismic acquisition & processing programs in Tuscany for a CBM project, collaborating with the OGS institute in Trieste, Italy.
