

STELIOS ZERVOS

Mr. Stelios Zervos works in Public Works Department (PWD) Ministry of Transport, Communication and Works (1992-today) and he is a Senior Executive Engineer and Head of the Coastal Section (PWD). Among other duties the Coastal Section deals with coastal erosion problems, design, supervision and management of the contracts for the construction works for coastline defence and fishing shelters and provision of technical advice to other Ministries, Departments, Services, and Organisations regarding coastal erosion and management.

Mr. Zervos has been participated in almost all studies carried out by PWD regarding coastal erosion problems and protection measures as a member and/or coordinator of the study team and he has worked as Project Engineer for almost all the PWD projects dealing with coastal erosion and fishing shelters since 2001.

Mr. Zervos participated in a number of EU funded projects regarding coastal erosion and coastal management as a member and/or leader/coordinator of the Cyprus team (ie Coastance, Costagap, Smartest etc). Mr. Zervos has been appointed by the Council of Ministers as a member of the national committees dealing with:

- CYS/Technical Committee 22 "Hydrocarbons"

In addition he has been appointed by the Minister of Transport, Communication and Works as the Coordinator Engineer regarding subsea pipeline licencing within the Exclusive Economic Zone and Self zone.
