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Training objectives

An online training on *Managing data within the social science infrastructures: the role of FOSSR*, organized by the Institute for Research on Population and Social Policy (CNR-IRPPS), curated by Fabrizio Pecoraro and Daniela Luzi, will take place on Nov. 6 and 7. It is part of the training offerings on **open science issues and social research methodologies for acquiring reliable and high-quality data** of the FOSSR (Fostering Open Science in Social Science Research) project.

The growing demand of sharing, archiving, planning and managing research data makes it especially urgent to train information experts with knowledge and skills in data management and curation that support long-term data preservation, access and reuse.

Effective data management can also help optimize research outputs, increase research impact and support open scientific inquiry.

Course description

The main purpose of this course is to **provide skills, tools and standards needed to integrate open science into the research workflow**. Legal and ethical aspects related to the management of personal and non-personal data will also be explored through specific experiences and case studies.

The training will be structured on the basis of 4 frontal lectures, in each of which there will be moments of lecturer-learner interactions that will allow experimentation with approaches and methodologies on real case studies.

Audience

The online training is of interest of (but not limited to) young researchers in the social sciences, especially those **in training**, who want to learn more about the methodologies and problematic aspects related to **data production, archiving and management**, and those who, coming from other disciplines, need to use **high-quality social data**.

Participation in the training will also be possible in groups, to encourage participants to share personal expertise and skills.
