

Andrea Cardarelli

Since 2007 Andrea Cardarelli is full professor of Prehistory and Protohistory at the Sapienza University of Rome - Department of Antiquity Sciences. Previously he was Director of the Ethnological Archaeological Museum of Modena and Professor of Prehistory and Protohistory at the University of Modena and Reggio Emilia. He is the author of two hundred scientific publications, particularly in the field of Italian and European Protohistory.

He has conceived and created various archaeological exhibitions and has provided for the rearrangement of archaeological museums. He was also P.I. of European project concerning archeological parks and open-air museums of European Protohistory, creating the terramara park in Montale (Modena). He is currently editor in chief of the scientific journal *Origini* and member of the Scientific Committee of the CNR and of the Museum of Civilizations. Since 2018 he is also vice-president of the Federation of University Councils of Archeology.
